

Healthy Homes Air Conditioning Program

The Healthy Homes Air Conditioning Pilot Program was created to eliminate heat-related hazards for vulnerable, low-income households in metropolitan Phoenix. This program provides free repair or replacement of an eligible homeowners' air conditioning system when outside temperatures reach 100+ degrees.

Furthermore, the program will provide valuable insights to better understand the benefits and costs of providing emergency air-conditioning repair or replacement assistance to the most heat-vulnerable seniors in our community, making their homes safer during the hot summer months. While limited in scope, our intent is to leverage program impact data to grow its reach in the future.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Program is offered seasonally, May through October
- Applicant must own the home within Metro Phoenix area
- Priority will be given to the elderly, persons with disabilities, or small children in the home
- Availability is very limited and subject to available funds
- Household income requirements follow Federal Poverty, as below:
