HEAF & URRD PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR DEPOSITS

Type of Assistance

Deposits for any utility company. Utility deposit included in a client's rental agreement and collected along with rental payments are eligible for assistance. Copy of the rental agreement or a note from the landlord is required.

Maximum Award Amount

\$3,000.00. Customers can receive assistance once in a 12-month period.

DO YOU QUALIFY?

- 1** Household income must be at or below 200% of the current Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines.
- 2** Crisis: None needed.
- 3** **Citizenship-Legal Residency:** Primary applicant must be U.S. citizen or legal resident. Documents verifying Citizenship/Legal Resident status must be provided to Caseworker.

HEAF & URRD PROGRAM

GUIDELINES FOR APPLIANCE REPLACEMENT

Type of Assistance

Replacement of existing utility related appliances only in cases where appliance is found to be inoperable with repairs. Replacement appliances must have an Energy Efficient Star Rating. Replacement must be for primary appliance.

Maximum Award Amount

\$3000.00. Customers can receive assistance once in a 12-month period.

DO YOU QUALIFY?

- 1** Household income must be at or below 200% of the current Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines.
- 2** **Crisis:** Crisis reason must be stated on application. Documents verifying crisis are NOT required.
Health and Safety Crisis: A condition that endangers the health and safety of the household must exist for appliance replacement.
- 3** **Citizenship-Legal Residency:** Primary applicant must be U.S. citizen or legal resident. Documents verifying Citizenship/Legal Resident status must be provided to Caseworker.
- 4** **Ownership:** The applicant must be the owner of the appliance or system to be repaired and/or replaced. For a list of documents that can be used to verify ownership: see page 3.
- 5** **Eligible Appliances:** Water Heaters, Cooking Stoves/Ovens, Microwaves, Furnaces, Air Conditioners, Evaporative Coolers, Refrigerators, and Washers/Dryers.

FSL HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE FUND (HEAF - URRD)

Required Documentation

After ALL the required documentation (APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITY) has been received, a FSL Program Caseworker will contact you within 5-7 business days to discuss any issues with documentation or schedule an application appointment via phone.

Failure to provide the required documentation will result in the DENIAL of the application.

- 1 Utility Bill/Letter of Deposit**
Copy of the rental agreement or a note from the landlord is required if deposit included in rent.
- 2 Proof of Appliance Ownership**
 - » Purchase receipt
 - » Statement of Ownership
- 3 Health and Safety Crisis**
A condition that endangers the health and safety of the household. (For URRD program-Appliance Replacement ONLY)
- 4 Household income for the last 30-days** (Must be at or below 200% federal poverty guidelines)
Social Security Award Letters, Pay stubs, etc.
- 5 Address Verification**
If service address is not listed on ID (Example: bill, mortgage statement, lease, etc.)
- 6 Citizenship/Legal Residency of Applicant**
 - » Birth Certificate
 - » U.S. Passport (Current or Expired)
 - » Resident Alien Card (Current)
 - » Certificate of Naturalization or U.S. Citizenship
 - » Tribal Enrollment Card or Certificate of Indian Blood

If one of the above is unavailable, additional methods of proof can be discussed with Caseworker.
- 7 MUST provide Social Security Number for ALL household members at time of application.**
Exception will be made to household members with no Social Security Number.
- 8 Each household member needs to provide ONE form of identity verification from this list:**
 - » Driver's License
 - » Work or School ID
 - » Social Security card
 - » Voter Registration card
 - » Wage stubs
 - » Birth Certificate
 - » ID card from health benefits or social service program
