



Tucson Weatherization Assistance Program

The Program

This FREE program enables low-income households to reduce their utility bills by making their homes more energy efficient. An emphasis is placed on assisting the elderly, the disabled, high energy users.

Typical Measures

- Air sealing to reduce infiltration.
- Testing, tuning and maintaining heating and cooling systems.
- Pipe and duct insulation.
- Replacing smoke detectors.
- Testing hot water heaters, stoves, and refrigerators for energy efficiency and safety.
- Shading sun exposed windows.
- installing energy efficient LED light bulbs.
- Homeowner energy education.

All qualified work performed is determined by diagnostic testing for program compatibility. Services rendered are determined on a case by case basis and available funding.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must live within the City of Tucson.
- Must own and live in your home for at least 12 months.
- Must meet income qualifications.
- Some renters may qualify in certain circumstances.

Applying is Simple

- Call Tucson Weatherization Assistance Program 520-485-4985 to request an application.
- Complete the application and obtain all required documents.
- Schedule an appointment with an intake specialist.

Once you qualify

- Your home will be assessed for program suitability.
- Professionally trained workers will weatherize your home.
- Once completed, work will be reviewed by qualified energy auditors.
